Southern Cross Uni – STAR Early Offer Applications Now Open Students can gain direct entry to Southern Cross University through STAR Early Offer. The program is open to all year 12 students with offers based on Principals' recommendation, not Year 12 results. STAR Early Offer allows Year 12 students to secure a place in an SCU degree before Year 12 results are released. Applications open Tuesday 28 April at www.scu.edu.au/star.

The University of Sydney, Early Offer Year 12 Scheme (E12/SRS) - Update to Eligibility The University of Sydney are pleased to share that eligibility for E12 has been extended this year to include students who attend a rural or regional school in NSW. Successful applicants receive conditional early entry with lower minimum ATAR requirements, in addition to a \$5950 scholarship to support their transition to university study.
