The Bert Evans Apprentice Scholarships are to assist apprentices who have experienced hardship in their life to successfully complete their apprenticeship.

The Bert Evans Apprentice Scholarships assist apprentices in NSW who have demonstrated:

- hardship in their personal circumstances
- aptitude for vocational education and training that leads to successful completion of their trade training
- a positive attitude and application in the workplace and in off-the-job training.

There will be a maximum of 100 Scholarships awarded in 2021, including up to 27 Scholarships for Indigenous Apprentices under the Western Sydney City Deal and up to 10 apprentices who have completed one of the 'Fit For Work' programs under the NSW Police Commissioner's RISEUP strategy.

Scholarships are open to NSW registered apprentices in both metropolitan and country areas, including school based apprentices.
